## PRESS STATEMENT FROM THE ASHANTI CAUCUS

### **CALL FOR CHANGE OF VENUE: A FIERY STAND FOR ELECTORAL FAIRNESS IN ASHANTI REGION.**

The Ashanti Caucus is outraged by the decision to hold the Ashanti Regional representative to the Council of State election at a venue already tainted by chaos and lawlessness. We refuse to allow the democratic process in our region to be compromised any further.

Today, we have officially dispatched a letter to the Electoral Commission demanding an immediate change of venue to the Central Police Station. A venue under the jurisdiction of a security apparatus that has already failed us is unacceptable and must be replaced without delay.

Furthermore, we will hold the current security leadership—specifically, the Inspector General of Police and the Chairman of the Regional Security Council—fully accountable for any further disruptions. If any lapses or incidents occur, these leaders will be held responsible without exception.

We have gathered intelligence that certain assemblies are becoming heated, with factions attempting to alter their representatives on the electoral roll. Moreover, reports indicate that today, coordinating directors have been instructed to swear in appointed assembly members to render them eligible to vote. Let us be crystal clear: any attempt to manipulate or destroy the sanctity of our electoral process will be met with unyielding resistance. We will resist every effort to subvert our democracy.

The governance of our region does not lie solely with any single political party. The voices of all our representatives must be respected and taken seriously in the interest of a governable and peaceful Ashanti. Indeed, we need an Ashanti that shares in the vision of the King—and nothing less.

This is a clear message to all well-meaning Ghanaians: we demand transparency, unwavering accountability, and a secure, neutral environment for our electoral process. Our democracy is not negotiable, and we will fight to protect it at all costs.
